Facility Specifications:

- Station #8 includes 800 sq. ft. St. George Police Department Substation
- Apparatus bay contains four drive through lanes to accommodate engines, aerial trucks, ambulances, heavy rescues, squads and command vehicles
- Large training room for up to 40 people
- Individual dorm rooms to accommodate eight personnel and four private restroom facilities for the staff
- Full size kitchen, laundry, dining area, day room, exercise room, and reception area
- Four offices and a reception area. Special equipment includes turnout lockers, equipment and hose storage room, automatic carbon monoxide exhaust system and automatic back up electrical generation

- Breathing air module to fill air equipment
